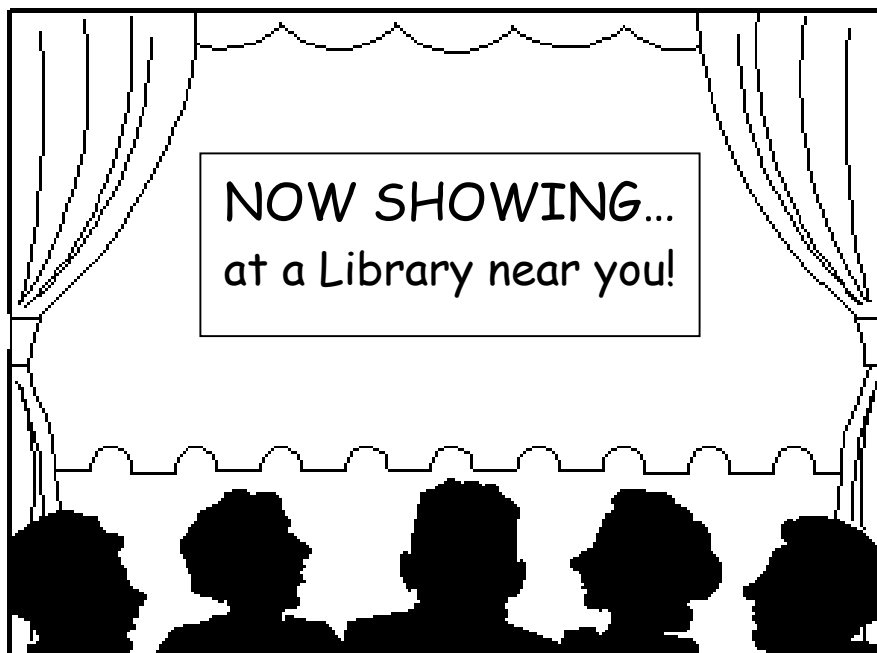

Feature Films

The 10th Kingdom (FVID)

When Virginia befriends a dog that is actually a bewitched prince from a parallel universe, their two worlds collide. Virginia, her father and the dog prince are transported through a magic mirror to The Land of Nine Kingdoms. Along the way, Virginia falls in love with Wolf, a complicated half-man, half-wolf, and the foursome meet up with Cinderella, Snow White and a grisly Troll King.

101 Dalmatians (XVID)

Dalmatians Pongo and Perdita settle into their owners' flat in London to become proud parents of 15 puppies. It's one big happy dog family until the evil Cruella De Vil kidnaps the puppies, along with every other Dalmatian in the city. Pongo and Perdita must unite the entire animal population in a mission to help the courageous pups outsmart their captor.

20,000 Leagues Under the Sea (FVID)

Captain Nemo guides the submarine Nautilus on a memorable voyage below the seven seas.

The Adventures of Milo and Otis (XVID)

A young cat and dog discover the dangers and delights of the outside world when they wander away from the farm.

Air Bud – World Pup (FVID)

Buddy the golden retriever teams up alongside U.S. Women's soccer greats Brandi Chastain, Briana Scurry and Tisha Venturini, while keeping a protective eye over his adorable new family of soccer-playing puppies.

Alaska (FVID)

Two teenagers challenge both nature and themselves on a death-defying mission through the arctic wilderness.

Andre (FVID)

A Maine harbormaster witnesses the impact of a playful seal on his hometown, his family, and especially on his shy nine-year-old daughter.

Anne of Green Gables (FVID)

A lonely couple arranges to adopt a boy but instead end up with wide-eyed, quixotic Anne of Green Gables.

Apollo 13 (FVID, FDVD)

Stranded 205,000 miles from Earth in a crippled spacecraft, three astronauts fight a desperate battle to survive. Meanwhile, at Mission Control, other astronauts, the flight director and a heroic ground crew race against time, to bring them home.

Apple Dumpling Gang (FVID)

Three frisky kids strike it rich during the California Gold Rush and set off the wildest bank robbery in the West, where robbers get robbed and con men get conned.

Back to the Future (FVID, FDVD)

A typical American teenager of the 1980's is accidentally sent back to 1955 in a plutonium-powered DeLorean "time machine."

Batteries Not Included (FVID)

An unscrupulous real estate developer sends thugs to a tenement to get rid of the last five tenants. The five are visited by tiny visitors from outer space, who turn the tide with magical powers.

The Bear (FVID)

An action-packed outdoor adventure tale about Youk, an orphaned bear cub, and the wounded giant grizzly that befriends him.

Bedknobs and Broomsticks (XVID)

An amateur witch and three children help save Britain from Nazi invaders.

Big (FVID)

A 12-year-old boy's wish comes true when he wishes to be "big." With a little help from Zoltar, a mechanical carnival genie, Josh wakes up one day as a 35-year-old man. Being a grown-up isn't easy when you've never done it before, but Josh manages to land a job at a toy company where he experiences the complications of being an adult.

Black Beauty (XVID)

A lyrical tale of the friendship between a young boy and his horse.

The Black Stallion (FVID)

Boy and horse are shipwrecked on an island where they become fast friends. Upon their return home they work together to try to win one of the great races at Santa Anita.

Call of the Wild (FVID)

During the Klondike gold rush, a stolen dog becomes a miner's best friend before joining a wolf pack.

Candlehoe (XVID)

Young orphan Casey pretends to be the long-lost granddaughter of the widowed owner of Candlehoe, hoping to find a hidden treasure.

Castaway Cowboy (XVID)

A shanghaied Texas cowpoke jumps ship in Hawaii and ends up turning a potato plantation into the island's first cattle spread.

Cats and Dogs (FVID, FDVD)

A look at the top-secret espionage war going on between cats and dogs, which humans know nothing about. Mr. Tinkle (a cat) plans to destroy a new vaccine, that if developed, would eliminate all human allergies to dogs, and would allow cats to rule the world. Lou, a beagle puppy, accidentally becomes the dog-agent assigned to stop the cat plan.

Chariots of Fire (FVID)

An exciting, inspiring true story of Harold Abrahams, Eric Liddell, and the dedicated team of athletic competitors who brought victory to Britain in the 1924 Olympics.

Chitty Chitty Bang Bang (XVID, XDVD)

Eccentric inventor Caractacus Potts, his two children and his lady friend go on a picnic at the beach where they are whisked into a magical world of pirates, castles and a flying car called Chitty Chitty Bang Bang. They then journey to Vulgaria and encounter the evil Baron Comburst and his child-hating wife, who kidnap Potts' children and steal the magic car. Potts plans an elaborate scheme to rescue the kidnapped children and Chitty Chitty Bang Bang from the castle.

Christy (FVID)

Christy Huddleston leaves home to teach school in the Smoky Mountains and comes to care for the mountain people, with their pride and poverty. She is able to break through walls of fear and generations of darkness to bring them into the 20th century.

Contact (FVID, FDVD)

Astronomer Dr. Ellie Arroway receives an encrypted message, apparently from a solar system many light-years away.

Corrina, Corrina (FVID, FDVD)

A story of a newly widowed man struggling to raise his little girl, and the woman who brings magic and laughter back into their lives when she comes to be their housekeeper.

E. T. The Extra-Terrestrial (FVID, FDVD)

A 10-year old boy befriends a creature from another planet that has been stranded on earth. This is a warm, insightful story of childhood innocence, frustration, courage and love.

The Education of Little Tree (FVID)

Little Tree is an 8-year-old Cherokee boy who, during the Depression, loses his parents and goes to live with his Cherokee grandparents and learn the wisdom of the Cherokee way of life.

Field of Dreams (FVID)

Ray Kinsella hears a voice, followed by a brief vision of a baseball field. He believes that if he builds a baseball diamond in his cornfield, Shoeless Joe Jackson from the infamous 1919 Chicago "Black" Sox will return to play baseball. By being willing to take a chance, Ray gets a second time up at bat in life.

Finding Buck McHenry (FVID)

When 11-year-old Jason Ross is cut from his little league team his undefeatable spirit leads him to try and create an expansion team. In searching for a new coach, Jason comes to believe that Mack Henry is really Buck McHenry, the legendary pitcher from the old Negro Baseball Leagues. While Mack begins to coach this rag-tag team, Jason and his friends set out to prove his true identity.

Fly Away Home (FVID)

A 13-year-old girl and her estranged father learn what family is all about when they adopt an orphaned flock of geese and teach them how to fly.

Foxfire (FVID)

When her son asks her to move to the city, an elderly woman is torn between his wishes and her many memories of sharing country life with her late husband.

Free Willy (FVID)

A story about the friendship that develops between a 12-year-old boy who knows what it's like to be without a family, and a whale confined in a too-small tank at an aquatic park.

Gidget (FVID)

Gidget goes to the beach over her summer vacation and finds herself adopted as the mascot of a group of college boys who surf at Malibu. Romance and fun follow the group in all their beach shenanigans.

Harry Potter and the Sorcerer's Stone (XVID, XDVD)

Rescued from the outrageous neglect of his aunt and uncle, a young boy with a great destiny proves his worth while attending Hogwarts School for Wizards and Witches.

Holiday in the Sun (XVID)

Twin girls are spending winter break at the lavish Atlantic Hotel on Paradise Island in the Bahamas. Amidst the parties, scuba diving, and moonlit strolls, the girls stumble across something sinister: a mysterious antiquities smuggling ring.

Hoosiers (FDVD)

An unwelcome outsider becomes the new coach of the underdog high school basketball team in a 1951 sleepy Indiana farm town, using methods that infuriate the townspeople.

It's a Wonderful Life (FVID)

An angel helps a compassionate but despairingly frustrated businessman by showing what life would have been like if he never existed.

Jason and the Argonauts (FVID)

A young Greek prince sees his father murdered by his uncle and flees, returning twenty years later to reclaim the throne. To save his own life, Prince Jason pledges to deliver the coveted Golden Fleece to his Uncle Pelias. Embarking with a crew of superheroes, he undertakes a perilous voyage to find his destiny.

Journey (FVID)

Grandparents help their grandson to understand why his family can't always live up to his expectations. By using photography, the grandfather recaptures Journey's past and with love and determination helps him to understand that family is just a group of people who love you.

The Jungle Book (XVID, XDVD)

Raised by wild animals since childhood, Mowgli is eventually drawn away from the jungle by Kitty, the beautiful daughter of Major Brydon. Mowgli soon faces a corrupt Captain Boone, who wants to marry Kitty and to find the mythical treasures of Monkey city-- a place only Mowgli can find. His loyal animal friends help Mowgli survive the untamed peril.

Lassie Come Home (XVID)

A collie undertakes a thousand-mile journey in order to meet her former master at the school gate.

A League of Their Own (FVID, FDVD)

A washed-up ballplayer is hired to coach in the All-American Girls Professional Baseball League while the male pros are at war in 1943, and finds himself drawn back into the game by the heart and heroics of his team.

A Little Princess (XVID, FDVD)

Sara Crewe, the pampered daughter of an Army officer, is left in a strict boarding school when her father goes off to war. When he is reported dead, her world is turned upside down and she is made a servant at the school, yet she refuses to let her spirit be broken.

Little Women (FVID)

A story about the March family of four daughters, a strong mother and a father away during the Civil War.

The Man from Snowy River (FVID, DVD)

Horse roundups, romance and a family feud on the Australian frontier in the 1880s.

Miracle on 34th Street (FVID)

A Macy's Department Store Santa who insists his name is Kris Kringle teaches everyone a lesson in love, faith and the value of imagination.

The Miracle Worker (FVID)

The story of Boston teacher Annie Sullivan's struggle to communicate with and teach the deaf, blind, and mute child, Helen Keller.

Moby Dick (FVID)

Sailor Ishmael tells the story of Captain Ahab, who sails on a vengeful quest to slay the legendary white whale known as Moby Dick.

Mr. Holland's Opus (FVID)

A frustrated composer comes to realize that his real passion is teaching, and that his legacy is not a truly memorable piece of music, but the generations of young people whose lives he affects.

Muppets from Space (XVID)

When Gonzo's extraterrestrial relatives plan a visit, the government captures him in order to find out when his relatives will arrive.

Music of the Heart (FVID)

A single mother with little more than talent and the determination to make a difference, Roberta Guaspari overcame the skepticism of everyone who didn't think she should be teaching violin to students in a tough inner-city neighborhood.

My Dog Skip (FVID, FDVD)

Willie Morris receives a talented terrier named Skip for his birthday. With Skip's remarkable and unconventional help, Willie and Skip turn bullies into friends, tangle with hapless moonshiners, and even win the affections of the prettiest girl in school.

National Velvet (FVID, FDVD)

Story of two children, their passion for a horse, and their determination to train it and win the Grand National.

The Natural (FVID, FDVD)

An overage baseball player comes out of seemingly nowhere to become a legendary player with almost divine talent.

Never Cry Wolf (FVID, FDVD)

An unforgettable adventure begins as Tyler, a young, inexperienced biologist, is deposited alone onto the desolate Arctic terrain. Once settled, he struggles to endure the forces of nature as he documents the mysterious habits of the wolves he has been sent to study.

O Pioneers! (FVID)

At the turn of the century, an immigrant's daughter inherits her family's Nebraska farm and her father's fierce love for the land. Fifteen years later, she has made the family a fortune through her canny management of the farm but has never forgotten the young man who left the prairie to seek his fortune.

October Sky (FVID)

The true story of a young boy growing up in Coalwood, West Virginia during the 1950's who dreams of building rockets.

Oliver Twist (XVID)

An orphan boy discovers good and evil forces on the streets of London and unwittingly seals his fate when he pickpockets his own grandfather.

On Golden Pond (FVID, FDVD)

This movie shows one summer in the life of a crotchety, retired university professor and his family and deals with the conflict among three generations.

Our Lips Are Sealed (XVID)

Twin girls eyewitness a crime and are forced to go undercover in the FBI Witness Protection Program. Unfortunately, not even the FBI can save the girls from their own blabbermouths as they blow their cover in town after town, until there's only one hiding place left-- Australia!

The Parent Trap (FVID)

Two young girls discover, while at summer camp, that they are twin sisters separated shortly after birth. Now that they are reunited, the girls launch a campaign to rekindle the romance between their estranged parents.

Prancer (XVID)

A little girl finds a wounded reindeer in the woods and believes it is Prancer. Her efforts to nurse it back to health so she can return it to Santa bring about wonderful changes in the lives of everyone-- her father, their neighbor, a grouchy vet, a department store Santa, and the people of the town.

The Princess Diaries (FVID, FDVD)

Mia is a frizzy-haired, glasses-wearing 15-year-old girl whose two highest ambitions are to become invisible and to get a few kisses from the school heartthrob. She is stunned when her continental grandmother shows up and informs her that she's the crown princess of the European principality Genovia. Soon enough, Mia has to undertake "princess lessons" (and a makeover) from her queenly grandmother, and eventually she blossoms into a confident, radiant girl.

A River Runs Through It (FVID)

The story of Norman and his brother Paul, an irresistible daredevil driven to challenge the world. Growing up, both boys rebel against their stern minister father. While Norman channels his rebellion into writing, Paul descends a slippery path to self-destruction.

Savannah Smiles (FVID)

Savannah, a runaway six-year-old, is thrown together with two escaped convicts. Savannah's father offers a huge reward for her safe return, believing her to be kidnapped--a reward two fugitives with a police record will have a great deal of trouble collecting. Hiding out in an abandoned house, Savannah, Alvie and Boots find the strong bond of love and family they've never known before.

Searching for Bobby Fischer (FVID)

The true story of a young boy who is a chess prodigy and his father, who attempts to walk the fine line between encouraging his son's talent and preserving the love they have for each other.

The Secret Garden (FVID, FDVD)

After the sudden death of her parents, Mary Lennox is sent from their home in India to the English estate of a distant family friend. Sad and lonely, her only interest lies in a secret garden, abandoned after a tragic accident occurred there. With the help of Dickon, an engaging local boy, and Colin, her guardian's invalid son, Mary's spirit is gradually reawakened as they bring the garden back to life.

Shane (FVID, FDVD)

A drifter and retired gunfighter assists a homestead family terrorized by an aging cattleman and his hired gun.

Shiloh (XVID)

When he finds a lost beagle in the hills behind his West Virginia home, Marty tries to hide it from his family and the dog's real owner, a mean-spirited man known to shoot deer out of season and to mistreat his dogs.

The Sign of the Beaver (FVID)

Left alone to guard the family's wilderness home in eighteenth-century Maine, a boy is hard-pressed to survive until local Indians teach him their skills.

Snow Dogs (FVID, FDVD)

When a Miami dentist inherits a team of sled dogs, he's got to learn the trade or lose his pack to a crusty mountain man.

Spy Kids (FVID, FDVD)

Nine years ago, top international spies Gregorio and Ingrid Cortez traded the excitement of espionage for the adventure of parenthood. But when they are called out on a secret mission, the Cortezes are separated from their family and kidnapped by the evil Fegan Floop. Fortunately, there are two people who possess the skills and know-how to reunite the family-- the kids!

The Straight Story (FVID)

Based on a true story about 73-year-old Alvin Straight who embarks on a dangerous and emotional journey to make amends with his 75-year-old brother Lyle before his brother dies. Alvin can no longer drive a car because of his eyesight and has to walk with 2 canes, but he climbs aboard his 1966 John Deere lawn mower and drives the 260-mile course from Laurens, Iowa to Mt. Zion, Wisconsin.

That Darn Cat! (XVID)

A young woman contacts the FBI when she becomes convinced that her cat (D.C.) can help crack a bank robbery and kidnapping case.

To Dance with the White Dog (FVID)

A devoted old couple are separated when the wife dies. The husband struggles to cope with his loneliness and failing health, but his spirit is fading when a mysterious white dog appears and reawakens his joy of life.

To Kill a Mockingbird (FVID, FDVD)

Two children in a small southern town are thrust into an adult world of racial bigotry and hatred when their lawyer father chooses to defend a black man unjustly accused of raping a white girl.

To Sir, With Love (FVID)

Tells the story of how a teacher in England abandons the traditional curriculum of education when dealing with a class of students rejected by other schools.

Treasure Island (FVID)

Young Jim Hawkins, Squire Trelawney, and Doctor Livesey outfit a ship to search for the treasure shown on Jim's map, but run into serious problems with Long John Silver and his pirate crew.

A Tree Grows in Brooklyn (FVID)

The story of a young girl in turn of the century Brooklyn who adores her charming but irresponsible father and resents her mother who tries to hold the family together.

True Grit (FVID, FDVD)

U.S. Marshall Rooster Cogburn is hired by a 14-year-old girl to kill the man who murdered her father and stole the family nest egg. She accepts the help of the Texas Ranger, who is intent on the reward, and accompanies them on the quest.

Where the Red Fern Grows (XVID)

More than anything else, Billy Coleman wanted a pair of hunting dogs. Following his grandfather's advice, Billy saved until he had enough money to buy them. Billy patiently trains them to hunt and they become the best in the state. Being best, however, is not always enough: love given and returned form the basis of true caring and courage.

Willow (FVID)

Willow Ufgood leaves his village to carry a special baby to safety. Aided by a swashbuckling warrior, Willow's quest is plagued by danger as the Powers of Darkness scheme to destroy the child -- a child destined to bring everlasting peace and freedom to the land.

Willy Wonka and the Chocolate Factory (XVID)

Join Charlie Bucket, his grandfather, and four lucky contest winners on a tour through the factory of the mysterious candy mogul Willy Wonka.

The Yearling (XVID)

A young boy living with his family on the Florida frontier shortly after the Civil War, must sacrifice his pet fawn for his family's survival.

Yours, Mine and Ours (FVID)

Find out what happens when Lucille Ball, who plays a widowed mother of eight, marries Henry Fonda, who plays a widower with ten children.

MUSICALS

Annie (FVID, FDVD)

Lavish musical production of the story about comic strip character Little Orphan Annie who is adopted by billionaire "Daddy" Warbucks.

Annie Get Your Gun (FVID)

Frank Butler, handsome star of Buffalo Bill's Wild West Show, bags clay pigeons and ladies' hearts. He's the best marksman in the world -- until a backwoods woman named Annie Oakley challenges him.

Funny Face (FVID)

A musical about Paris, the world of high fashion, photography and models -- and love.

Guys and Dolls (FVID, FDVD)

A gentleman-gambler falls in love with a missionary, while a floating crap-game operator avoids marriage to his long-time fiancée.

Joseph and the Amazing Technicolor Dreamcoat (FVID)

A lively and colorful journey through ancient Egypt, this musical follows the rags-to-riches story of Joseph, his eleven brothers and the coat of many colors.

Mary Poppins (FVID, XVID)

Mary Poppins captures the hearts and imaginations of her two young charges.

The Music Man (FDVD)

Silver-tongued con artist Harold Hill hoodwinks the stubborn townsfolk of River City, Iowa into buying instruments and uniforms for a boys band, but his game ultimately – and romantically – backfires.

My Fair Lady (FVID)

A Cockney waif is transformed by a linguistics professor into an elegant lady.

Oliver! (XVID)

As a young orphan, Oliver is left to fend for himself until he is befriended by a band of young thieves who quickly train him in their craft. Oliver is not content to be a thief, for he knows that life holds great joys and that true happiness cannot be stolen but must be earned.

Pete's Dragon (XVID)

An orphan boy and his dragon Elliot, who is invisible at will, have many adventures before they find a suitable family to live with.

Pirates of Penzance (FVID)

A group of pirates who can't seem to make piracy pay fall in love with the ten daughters of a major general.

Singin' in the Rain (FVID)

A great song-and-dance piece that is an affectionately funny insider spoof about the film industry's uneasy transition from silent pictures to "talkies."

The Slipper and the Rose (FVID)

A musical retelling of the popular "Cinderella" story – with a few twists.

The Sound of Music (FVID, FDVD)

A woman leaves an Austrian convent to become a governess to a Naval officer widower.

The Wizard of Oz (FDVD)

Dorothy, her dog Toto, and three friends set off for the mysterious Emerald City in search of the Wizard. They are pursued by the Wicked Witch of the West, but they finally reach the Emerald City and receive an audience with the Wizard.

ANIMATED FILMS

Alice in Wonderland (XVID)

An animated musical version of Lewis Carroll's tale about a girl named Alice. Alice follows a White Rabbit through a very small door and enters Wonderland, where she has many unusual adventures.

An American Tail (XVID)

This film follows the humorous and dramatic adventures of Fievel, a mouse who journeys from Russia to America with his family to seek a new life free of cat persecution. During the stormy boat trip Fievel is lost at sea, finally washing up ashore in New York Harbor, where he vows to find his family.

Animal Farm (FVID)

Farmer Jones' domesticated animals revolt against their cruel master and are then taken over by the pigs. They soon find they have succeeded in exchanging one form of tyranny for another, and once again are forced to unite in a common cause.

Bambi (XVID)

The adventures of a young deer growing up in a forest.

Beauty and the Beast (XVID, XDVD)

The spell of an enchantress opens this classic fairy tale, turning a cruel prince into a hideous beast. Belle is a book-loving young lady trapped by the beast when she comes looking for her father. To break the spell, the beast must win Belle's love before the last petal falls from an enchanted rose.

A Bug's Life (XVID, XDVD)

Journey inside the miniature world of bugs where an ant named Flik hires warrior bugs to defend his colony from a horde of freeloading grasshoppers.

Charlotte's Web (XVID)

The story of Wilbur the pig and his friendship with Charlotte the spider. A tale of friendship and salvation; a story of the miracles of birth, friendship and death.

Chicken Run (FVID)

Rocky the rooster and Ginger the chicken decide to rebel against the evil Mr. and Mrs. Tweedy, the owners of the chicken farm where they live. Rocky and Ginger lead their fellow chickens in a great escape from the farmers.

Cinderella (XVID)

A mistreated kitchen maid, with the help of her fairy godmother, attends the palace ball on the condition that she must leave before midnight.

The Emperor's New Groove (XVID, XDVD)

Arrogant Emperor Kuzco is turned into a llama by his devious advisor, Yzma, and her hunky henchman, Kronk, who want to rid the kingdom of this beast of burden. Now the ruler must form an unlikely alliance with a pleasant peasant named Pacha. Together, Kuzco and Pacha must overcome their differences as they embark on a hilarious adventure.

Fantasia (XVID)

A collection of animated interpretations of great works of classical music.

The Hunchback of Notre Dame (XVID, XDVD)

Quasimodo ventures from his tower to the joyous festival of fools, but the crowd turns cruel and rejects him because of the way he looks. The gypsy Esmeralda rescues him and he finds himself battling to save the people and the city he loves -- while reminding us to see people as they are rather than how they appear.

James and the Giant Peach (XVID, XDVD)

A wildly imaginative tale about a little boy who journeys to a wondrous city "where dreams come true."

The King and I (XVID)

Traveling to the exotic kingdom of Siam to instruct the royal children, English schoolteacher Anna Leonowens soon discovers that her most difficult challenge is the stubborn, imperious king himself. But even as a wondrous friendship grows between Anna and the arrogant monarch, an evil sorcerer is conjuring up a plot to steal the throne.

The Lion King (XVID)

Captivating story of a young lion that is tricked out of his kingdom by his wily uncle, only to discover his inner strength and return to fight for what is his.

The Many Adventures of Winnie the Pooh (XVID)

These charming stories are filled with timeless Pooh adventures -- the first meeting between Tigger and Pooh, Pooh getting stuck in Rabbit's house from eating too much honey, and the lovable characters' flurry of activity on a windy day.

Mulan (XVID)

When Mulan's aging father is drafted into the Imperial army to fight the invading Hun army, she disguises herself as a soldier and takes his place. Mulan's hilarious guardian dragon and lucky cricket are not enough to help her defeat the ruthless Hun leader; only by staying true to herself will she bring victory to her country and honor to her family.

Pinocchio (XVID)

A puppet named Pinocchio wants to be a boy, and a fairy promises boyhood to him if he can prove he is kind, honest and loving. A wayward huckster tries to lead Pinocchio astray, but Pinocchio decides to perform a redeeming act of bravery and kindness.

Pocahontas (XVID, XDVD)

The Sword in the Stone (XVID)

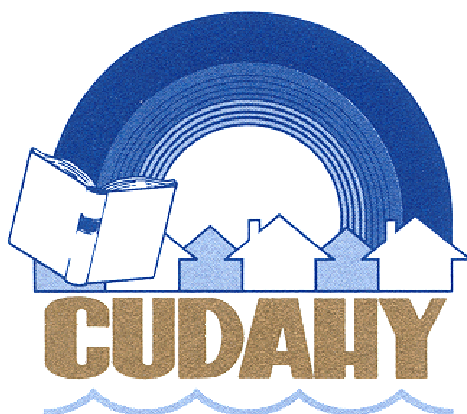
