Allman, Gregg *My Cross to Bear*

Offering a colorful portrait of growing up in the 1960s South, rock icon Greg Allman, who, with the Allman Brothers Band, defined the meaning of rock and roll, reveals the bands' many struggles, hardships, personality clashes and ultimately the joy that went into making some of the most electrifying rock and roll ever recorded.

Bell, Ted *Phantom*

When a Russian sub in the Caribbean is hijacked, American anti-ballistic missiles explode in their silos and a USAF F-15 launches sidewinder missiles at an aircraft it was meant to protect, counterspy Alex Hawke and his M16 colleague Ambrose Congreve are sent in to investigate.

Bowen, Rhys *Hush Now, Don't You Cry*

A latest entry in the Anthony Award and Agatha Award-winning series finds a newly married Molly and her NYPD captain husband reluctantly honeymooning in 1904 Newport at the estate of an ambitious Tammany Hall politician whose subsequent murder challenges Molly's resolve to avoid sleuthing.

Box, C. J. *Force of Nature*

Having hidden the truth about a past colleague's violation, former Special Forces agent Nate Romanowski is targeted by a determined killer who threatens Joe Pickett's life as part of a violent plot.

Brockmann, Suzanne *Born to Darkness*

Though Mac--a super-human "Greater Than"--is used to doing things her own way, she is forced to cooperate with a former NAVY Seal (with whom she has a sizzling sexual connection) to save a kidnapped girl who also has the potential to be a "Greater Than."

Childs, Laura *Agony of the Leaves*

Charleston Aquarium and begins an investigation despite emergency responders believing it to be an accident in the latest Tea Shop mystery following *Scones and Bones*.

Coben, Harlan *Stay Close*

A bored suburban wife, a documentary photographer-turned-paparazzo and a detective who cannot let go of a cold case hide secrets from their loved ones only to have the past return in dangerous ways.

Coughlin, Jack & Davis, Donald A. *Running the Maze*

When her military doctor brother dies from a suspicious bridge collapse moments after sending her a cellphone photo, a Coast Guard sniper struggles to solve the mystery by investigating the photo and enlisting the aid of a special operations team that subsequently discovers an al-Qaeda plot.

Cussler, Clive & Scott, Justin *The Thief*

When a scientist he recently rescued from kidnappers is murdered, Van Dorn Detective Agency chief investigator Isaac Bell discovers that the scientist's secret new invention has the power to revolutionize business and that a ruthless agent is looking to exploit the innovation to seize power for Germany.

A latest entry in the trilogy that includes *Me, Myself, and Why?* finds FBI agent Cadence considering a deeper relationship with Patrick during the holiday season before meeting a handsome doctor, clashing with a talented rival and investigating the work of an enigmatic serial killer.

Dorgan, Byron L. & Hagberg, David *Blowout*

When the U.S. President hires a top-secret research team to develop a clean energy source to minimize a troubled America's dependence on foreign oil, war hero Sheriff Nate Osborne and brash journalist Ashley Borden investigate a saboteur's attack on the initiative's experimental power station.

Fluke, Joanne *Cinnamon Roll Murder*

When the keyboard player for the Cinnamon Roll Six jazz band is murdered after a tour bus accident on the way to Lake Eden, Minnesota, Hannah Swensen, after digging up several local suspects, discovers that there is nothing sweeter than catching a killer.

French, Nicci *Blue Monday*

Living an existence of austere control and personal integrity borne from her views about what she can control in an uncontrollable world, psychotherapist Frieda Klein is placed

at the center of a national investigation involving the abduction of a 5-year-old child and a client who harbors an obsessive longing for a child with the missing boy's physical appearance.

Harrison, Kathryn *Enchantments*

Patterson, James & Ellis, David *Guilty Wives*

The vacation of a lifetime in Monte Carlo turns into a hellish nightmare when best friends Abbie, Winnie, Serena and Bryah are arrested aboard an unfamiliar yacht and accused of an unthinkable crime.

Patterson, Richard North *Fall From Grace*

Attending the funeral of his estranged father and encountering an estate of complicated legal and financial arrangements, CIA operative Adam Blaine embarks on a search for his father's killer that implicates members of his own family and reveals astonishing secrets.

Perry, Thomas *Poison Flower*
