Siddons, Anne Rivers *Off Season*

A grieving widow takes a solitary road trip to her late husband's favorite getaway on pristine coastal Maine, where she remembers their many happy years of family life, reevaluates the time before they met, and considers her future.

Steel, Danielle *Rogue*

An amicably divorced couple--Blake, a charismatic, globe-trotting, dot-com entrepreneur, and Maxine, an expert on childhood trauma and adolescent suicide--confront a life-changing choice as Maxine falls in love with Dr. Charles West, and Blake finds himself dealing with hundreds of orphaned children after a devastating earthquake near one of his foreign homes.
